3) Presidents Report

Cathy Cooney stated it was a privilege to present the President's report for 2023.

A highlight of the year was four candidates achieving Fellowship by exam in Perth in October 2022. Cathy acknowledged the Council members and many others who had contributed to the College activities over the past year.

Highlights and key achievements throughout the year included:

- 1. A positive meeting with Margie Apa as CEO of Te Whatu Ora. Margie at the meeting expressed a commitment to working in partnership with ACHSM-Aotearoa in relation to health leadership and management and particularly a competency framework.
- 2. The development and printing of our postcards which can be used to promote the College.
- 3. Taking a regional approach with the set up being driven by Marion Dixon, with a focus on a more informal approach to support and collegiality. Marion will assist other regions to get off-the-ground.
- 4. In 2024, we will host the College's annual one-day conference (usually held in Melbourne but will be hosted in Auckland next year).

Cathy declared a Conflict of Interest in relation to the development of the ACHSM-Aotearoa brand and logo. A defined process was followed to award a graphic design company this task. Because Cathy Cooney's niece was a tenderer, Cathy absented herself from all decisions and discussions relating to the award of the tender. At ACHSM-A board meetings, this process was instead led by Cathy Cummings. This process was described and explained at the AGM. No concerns were raised by any members present.
