Calling for Interest in the 2022 Fellowship Programme

We welcome expressions of interest from College Associate Fellows and members who are interested in doing the Fellowship programme in 2022. It involves approximately seven months of engagement through an online 'learning set' forum coordinated by Jagpal Benipal, the Fellowship Programme Coordinator. The Fellowship candidates meet virtually monthly to discuss the readings for the month on topics such as health systems, quality and safety, indigenous health

and equity, leadership, workforce, data and digital, long term conditions, health systems funding, aged care, mental health services, capital investment, asset management, risk management and much more. The monthly readings have an international flavour however Jagpal ensures there are also readings relevant to Aotearoa which are updated each year. For 2022 you can expect readings on topics such as the Health System reforms, the Mental Health Service changes, Māori Health and equity etc. There is also ample opportunity for sharing about your real-time challenges such as managing during a global pandemic.

Jagpal shares about why he makes the commitment to be the Fellowship Programme Coordinator for ACHSM-Aotearoa each year:

I take pride in supporting and enabling Fellowship Candidates to successfully prepare for the Fellowship examination. My goal is for Candidates to have a positive learning experience while further developing their knowledge, skills and competencies to better manage health and disability services.
